

## INVESTMENT OBJECTIVE & POLICY

The primary objective of the OIG Islamic Balanced Portfolio is to offer investors long term capital growth. All of the underlying funds complies with Shariah (Islamic Law) and the standards prescribed by the Accounting and Auditing Organization for Islamic Financial Institutions (AAOIFI). The portfolio will be managed in compliance with prudential investment guidelines for retirement funds in South Africa to the extent allowed for the Act.

In order to achieve its objective, the model invests in a combination of collective investment schemes held in specified proportions which is in accordance with Islamic law and adhering to the principles that govern it. The underlying investments normally to be included in the portfolio may comprise of a combination of assets in liquid form, sukuks, equity securities and property securities. The Manager may invest in participatory interests or any other form of participation in portfolios of collective investment schemes or other similar collective investment schemes as the Act may allow from time to time, and which are consistent with the portfolio's investment policy. The portfolio may from time to time invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments, in accordance with the provisions of the Act, and the regulations thereto, as amended from time to time, in order to achieve the portfolio's investment objective. The manager may also include forward currency, interest rate and exchange rate swap transactions for efficient portfolio management purposes. The manager shall have maximum flexibility in terms of asset allocation and shall not be precluded from continually varying the ratio of securities, non-equity securities and assets in liquid form. The portfolio's net equity exposure will range between 0% and 60% of the portfolio's net asset value.

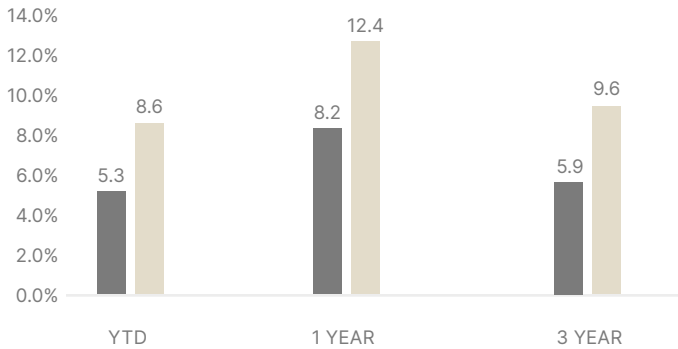

Legend: OIG Islamic Balanced Portfolio (Dark Grey), (ASISA) South African MA High Equity (Light Brown)

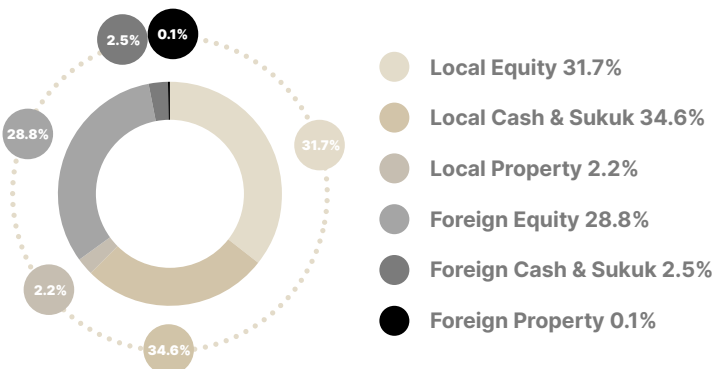

## GROWTH OF R100



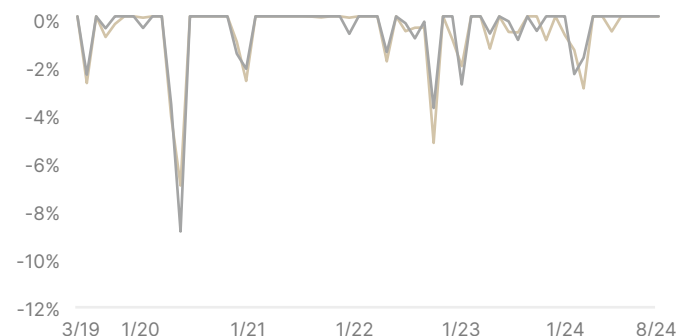
